

# Hamilton County Election Board Minutes

## Friday, June 12, 2020

Meeting called to order by Chairman Adler at noon.

Clerk Williams presented the minutes from the May 4<sup>th</sup> meeting. Mr. Purvis made a motion to accept the minutes, Clerk Williams seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

Clerk Williams presented the minutes from the June 2-3 meeting. Mr. Purvis made a motion to accept the minutes with the addition of adding June 3<sup>rd</sup> to a paragraph. Clerk Williams seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

Clerk Williams presented to the Election Board the Voter Registration rejected applications for this election.

Joyce Wielenski presented the 5 Provisional ballots from the 2020 Primary Election:

Beth Ann Elmore – not registered in Hamilton County – Mr. Purvis made a motion to reject the ballot, Clerk Williams seconded, motion carried unanimously

Alexander S Rodgers – registered in Hamilton County but has lived in Marion County more than 30 days before the election – Mr. Purvis made a motion to reject the ballot, Clerk Williams seconded, motion carried unanimously

Allison Evonich – registered in Hamilton County but has lived in Marion County more than 30 days before the election - Mr. Purvis made a motion to reject the ballot, Clerk Williams seconded, motion carried unanimously

Gregory Jenks – was registered at his old address, but still lives in Hamilton County

Jennifer Jenks – was registered at her old address, but still lives in Hamilton County – Mr.

Purvis made a motion to count the 2 ballots from Gregory and Jennifer Jenks, Clerk Williams, seconded, motion carried unanimously

Mrs. Wielenski then presented a military ballot from Bryan Birbiglia. It was returned within the 10 day period after the election. Clerk Williams made a motion to count the ballot, Mr. Purvis seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Mrs. Wielenski then presented an absentee ballot that was received from Boone County with a note that it was received by election day at noon. Clerk Williams made a motion to count the ballot, Mr. Purvis seconded the motion, motion carried unanimously.

Beth Sheller tabulated the ballot cards from the four approved ballots. The new Summary Sheet was printed, approved, and signed by the Election Board.

The Election Board approved and signed the CEB-9, certifying the 2020 Primary Election Results.

Mr. Purvis made a motion to dismiss at 12:48 pm. President Adler seconded, and meeting was dismissed.
