Special Events Weather Watcher/Event Ready Program

Overview

The National Weather Service and Hamilton County Emergency Management will host a weather and emergency management training program designed for outdoor event organizers and decision makers. The goal of the course is to:

1. Provide event organizers with weather resources and National Weather Service data
2. Understand how to interpret the data in order to make informed decisions regarding event safety such as sheltering or evacuation decisions
3. Lead participants through a coordinated assessment of weather concerns
4. Provide an overview of emergency management and how it can support events

Who Should Attend

Anyone who organizes or manages outdoor weather events such as school officials, parks personnel, race organizers, festival organizers, and anyone else who may need to make a decision regarding weather that may impact an outdoor special event.

The course will be held on Thursday, May 10th from 3:00 P.M. to 4:30 P.M.
