

# Hamilton County Bridge 207 Logan Street over White River Rehabilitation, Widening and Lighting for Pedestrian Path

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

This is a joint project between Hamilton County and the City of Noblesville. The existing bridge is being rehabilitated and widened to provide pedestrian connectivity between downtown Noblesville, River Walk and Federal Hill Commons Park. A pedestrian path protected from the traffic will be added to the south side of the bridge. Decorative lighting will be installed along the path.

## WORK SUMMARY FOR WEEK ENDING 12/07/19

- Formed and poured the north sidewalk and the interior conc. railing
- Removed the causeway and placed salvaged rip-rap (Bent 1 to Pier 2)
- Poured the stairway landings and began forming the steps
- R&M installed the ornamental railing and the north side bridge lights

## WORK PLANNED FOR WEEK ENDING 12/14/19

- Form and pour the SE and SW railing transitions.
- Form and pour the stairway steps and misc. concrete
- Install railings and guardrail.
- R&M will install flood light foundations and finish electrical work on the ornamental railing
