

Hamilton County Bridge 207 Logan Street over White River Rehabilitation, Widening and Lighting for Pedestrian Path

PROJECT OVERVIEW

This is a joint project between Hamilton County and the City of Noblesville. The existing bridge is being rehabilitated and widened to provide pedestrian connectivity between downtown Noblesville, River Walk and Federal Hill Commons Park. A pedestrian path protected from the traffic will be added to the south side of the bridge. Decorative lighting will be installed along the path.

WORK SUMMARY FOR WEEK ENDING 12/14/19

- Formed and poured steps, transitions, and misc. concrete
- Installed railing for the inside wall. Poured the north wall correction
- Removed overhang forms. Demobilized equipment and materials
- R&M worked on the bridge lights, west flood lights, and rail wiring

WORK PLANNED FOR WEEK ENDING 12/21/19

- Form and pour the remaining misc. concrete
- Install guardrail and finish the north bridge railing installation
- Remove temporary barriers and prepare to open the bridge on 12-23-19
- R&M will continue to work on wiring and the installation of the east flood lights.
